# Who's your memorable partner?

Each of you may have your own memorable Pokémon, but this time, we will introduce the charms and memories of all 24 starter Pokémon, from the very first title up to Pokémon Sword and Shield, along with comments from Pokémon Trainers.



I chose \Chikorita/  
Trainer name: Uichan's Dad (10s)

I was fascinated by its indescribable smooth form and decided on Chikorita. Some Pokémon change their style quite a bit as they evolve, but I like how Chikorita remains mellow until the end.



I chose \Cyndaquil/  
Trainer name: Foodie (10s)

I chose Cyndaquil because I thought the flames on its back looked cool. Since I progressed through the game using Cyndaquil in almost all battles, I had a hard time against the gym leaders in Goldenrod City.

Trainer name: Radish (under 10)

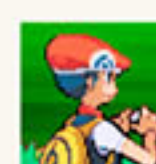

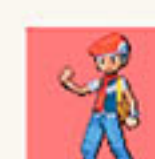

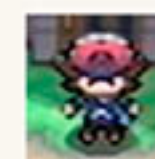

# A closer look at the detective duo



## The human-Pokémon detective duo who are the talk of the town in Ryme City.

Ryme City is a place where humans and Pokémon live in harmony. I was unsure if this city's soft, floral scent came from a flower shop or a grass-type Pokémon, but I came to this peaceful town to interview a detective duo of Tim Goodman and his partner Pikachu. They are rumored to have solved numerous cases in the city. A human-Pokémon detective duo is something you don't often hear, so as a reporter, I felt a spark of joy throughout this rare opportunity. Also, they are apparently endorsed by the mayor of the city, Howard Clifford. I interviewed the detective duo closely to find out what kind of investigations they do to get to the bottom of cases and why the people of Ryme City love them so much.

## A Unique Pikachu

This Pikachu, wearing a detective hat, is Tim's partner. At first glance, he seemed like an ordinary Pikachu, but I noticed his unusual behaviors after interviewing him closely. First of all, he loves coffee; something already seemed strange at this point. Tim was calling the city's famous Hi-Hat Café the "Pikachu Trap," but this Pikachu is probably the only Pikachu that falls for it. Also, his movements, such as how he lies on the bed at home, were somewhat like those of a middle-aged man. I was surprised by the difference between his cute looks and his behavior.

## Why they are great detectives

We followed Tim and Pikachu as they were investigating a case, and they seemed to be in perfect synch as if they could communicate with each other. When Pikachu was sometimes messing around, Tim was warning him to quit goofin' off and investigate. At first, I thought Tim was the one pulling the strings, but that didn't seem to be the case. Middle-agedness turned into "dignity" in the investigation scene, and if anything, Pikachu appeared to be leading Tim, which was curious. Also, in addition to interviewing the people around them, they were talking to Pokémon. I wonder if they could get any information from them... At times, we saw Pikachu riding on Growlithe, which has a sharp sense of smell, and they appeared to be tracking the scent of something. The duo seemed to be well-liked by the Pokémon, as I saw other Pokémon also using their special skills to assist their investigations. The practice of the fundamentals — careful listening and persistent investigation — may be the very reason why they are called the great detectives.

As the duo were investigating, Pikachu cried, "Pika Pika!" and seemed to have noticed something, and Tim nodded deeply. It appeared that they had found a clue to solving the case. In other words, they were about to solve the case with a "bolt of brilliance."

## Where do humans and Pokémon go from here?

Humans and Pokémon have been living together for a long time. In Ryme City, people and Pokémon work, play, and live together. Pokémon are companions, friends, and family. Tim and Pikachu respect each other and are willing to talk to and understand both humans and Pokémon; this is probably the reason why this duo is so beloved. Even though Pokémon and humans are different species and don't speak the same language, Pokémon and humans will forever be good partners as long as they are considerate of each other and willing to get to know each other. By the way, Pokémon Friendship Week, which promotes an even stronger bond between the people and Pokémon, has started in Ryme City. We will continue monitoring it to find out what it is all about.
