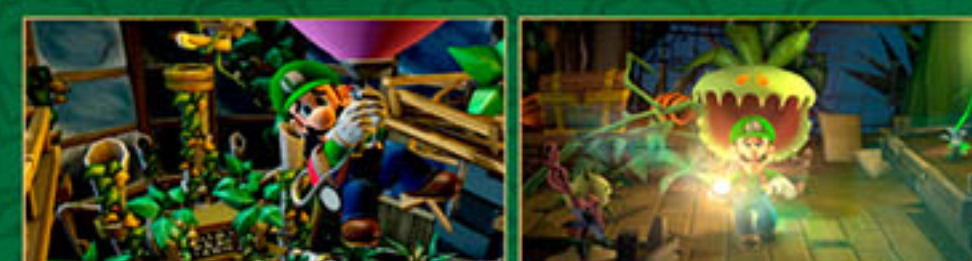

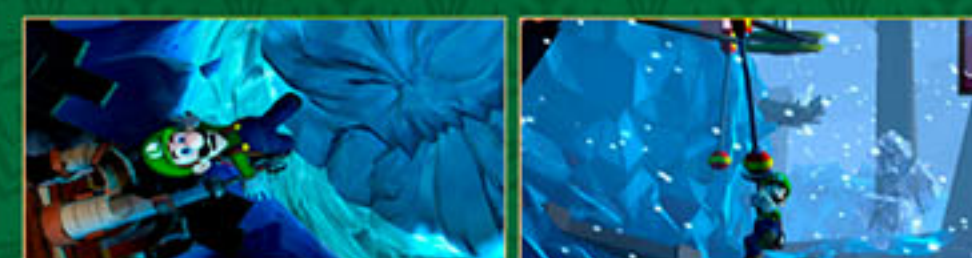

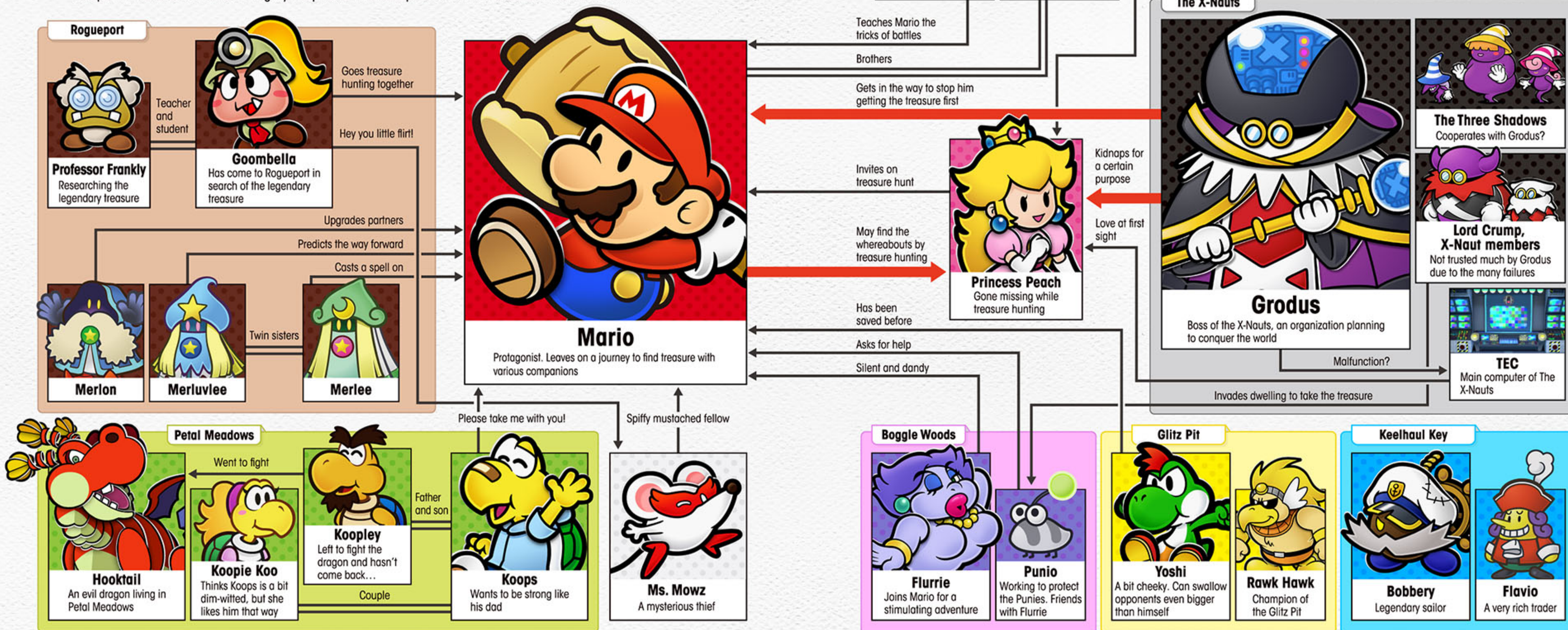

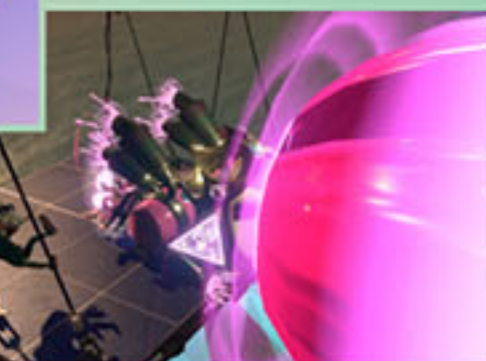
Marina

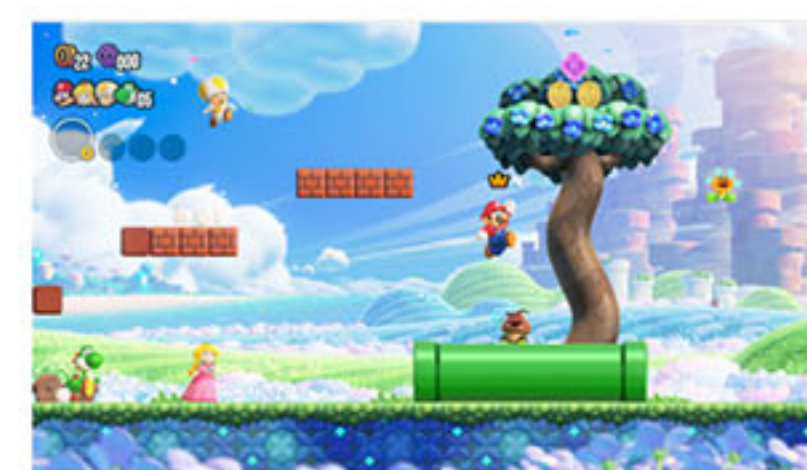

The family starts playing "Welcome to the Flower Kingdom!" The children move around in all directions while the parents take careful steps. Will they be able to reach the goal together?

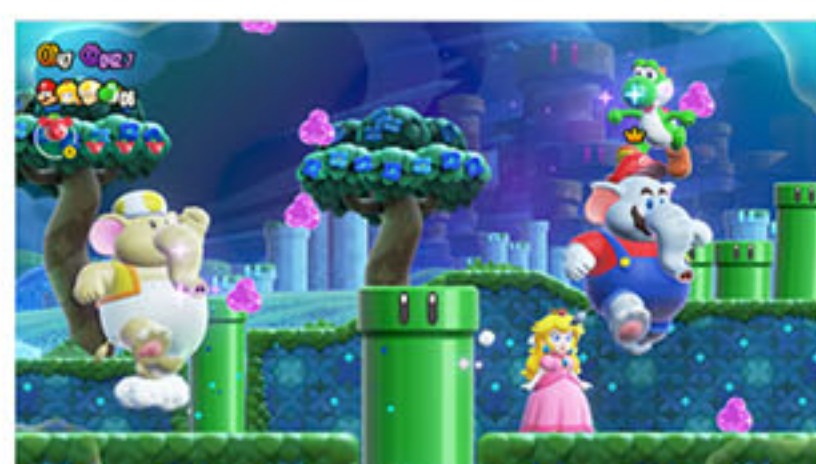

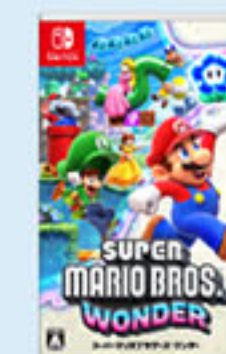
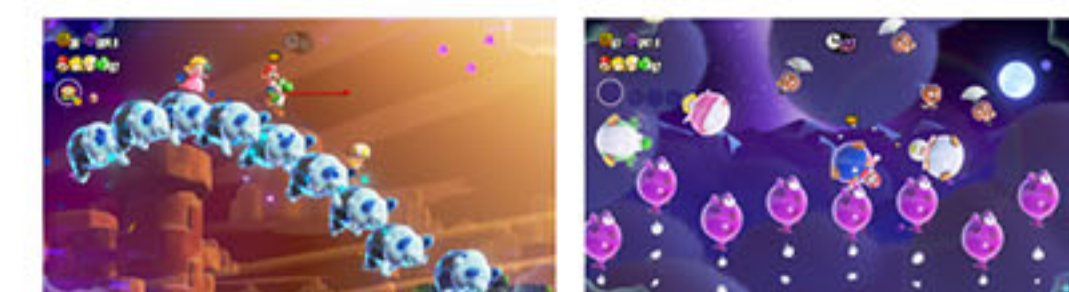
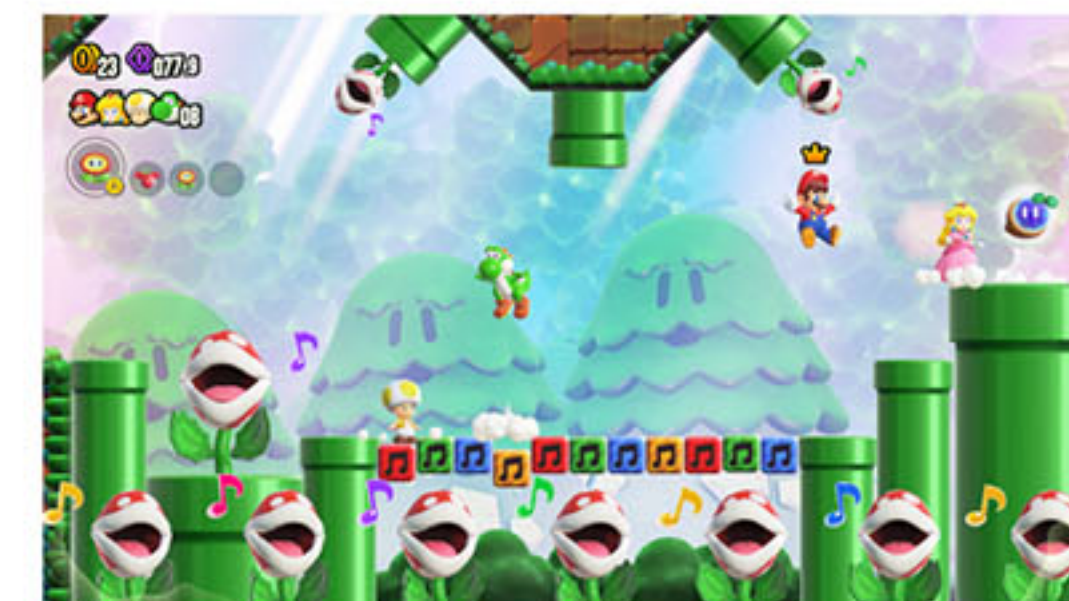
Experience a variety of wonders

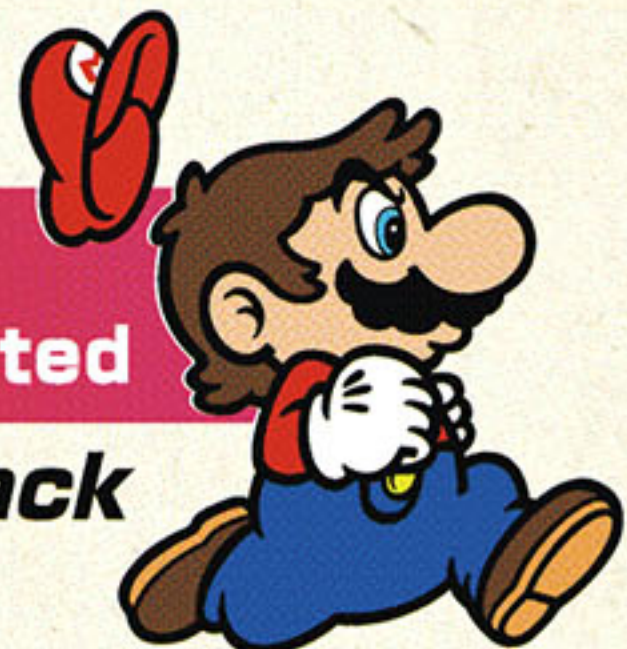

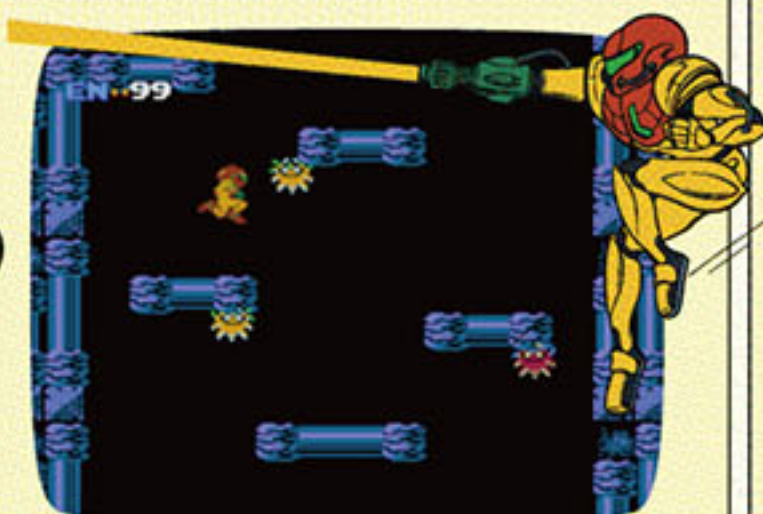

Tip 2 Keep your jumps short and few
