Ecology of the Triumvirate

Recently, three enormous King Salmonids have been spotted together in the Splatlands. Grizzco calls this troop the "Triumvirate". In preparation for the coming attack from the Triumvirate, we will introduce their behavior.

Horrorboros

A King Salmonid with a well-developed body through grueling waterfall climbing. They attack with powerful bombs made by mixing electricity stored in their body with ink, but the bombs burst on the spot when hit by egg cannon or ink.

Cohozuna

A King Salmonid characterized by a giant body. They attack the nearest Clock Puncher and occasionally make big jumps to emit a shockwave.



They have an excellent jumping ability that is hard to imagine from their huge body. ▶

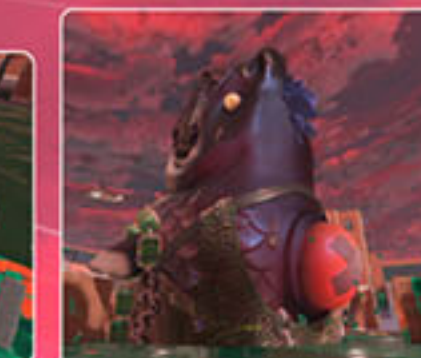

Megalodontia

The biggest King Salmonid of the Triumvirate. They lock on a Clock Puncher and attack from underground with their mouth wide open, swallowing everything around it, even other Salmonids.

▲ Their weak point is the bump on the back.

Grizzco Weapons

Dubious weapons modified by Grizzo. Sometimes they are mixed in with the supplied weapons by mistake (?). In exchange for their large ink consumption, they boast outstanding performances, far superior to normal weapons, and may be reliable weapons when fighting the powerful Triumvirate.



When can they be used?

- 1 When the supplied weapon icon is shown as "?" (random)
It may be a Grizzco Weapon
- 2 When the Triumvirate appears
Everyone will be supplied with a Grizzco Weapon

When does the Triumvirate appear?



When the Salmometer is in the shape shown on the right, the Triumvirate will appear in an XTRAWAVE. An XTRAWAVE may occur after clearing Wave 3, and the more the Salmometer is filled, the higher the probability of occurrence.



Memo from Mr. Grizz

Every crisis can be an opportunity. For example, Megalodontia's bite will one-shot not just you but its own Salmonid allies. And if you play it smart, you can lure Horrorboros into launching its bomb at a group of Salmonids. Exploit the enemy's friendly fire for maximum job efficiency!

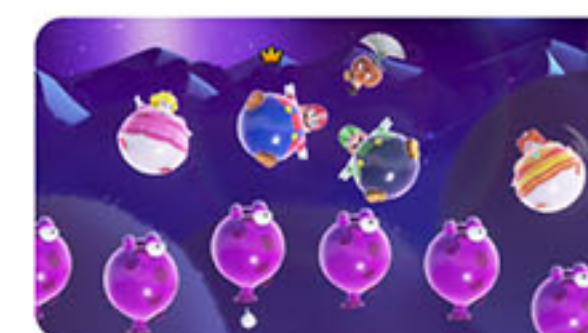

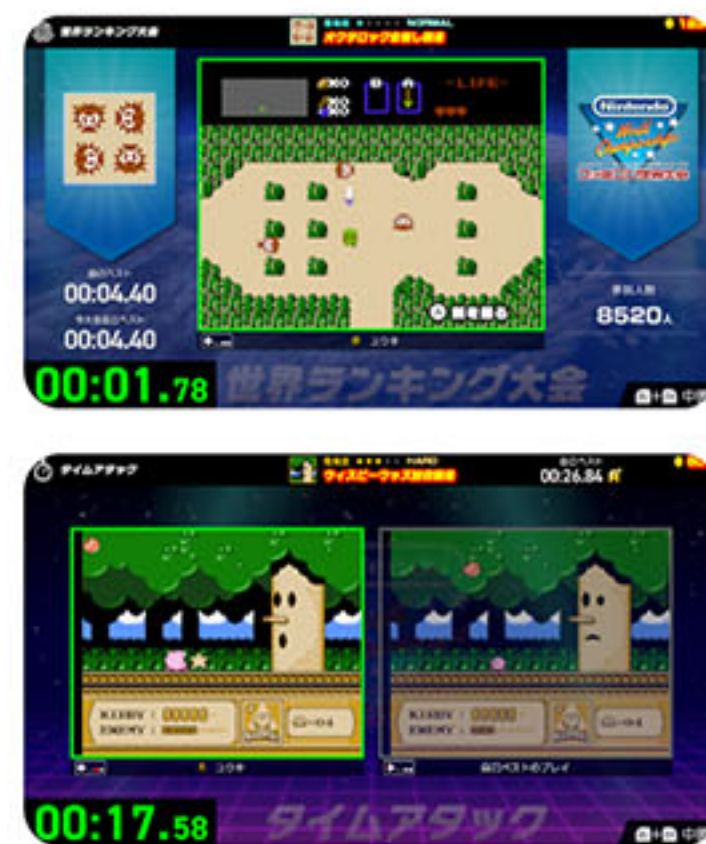
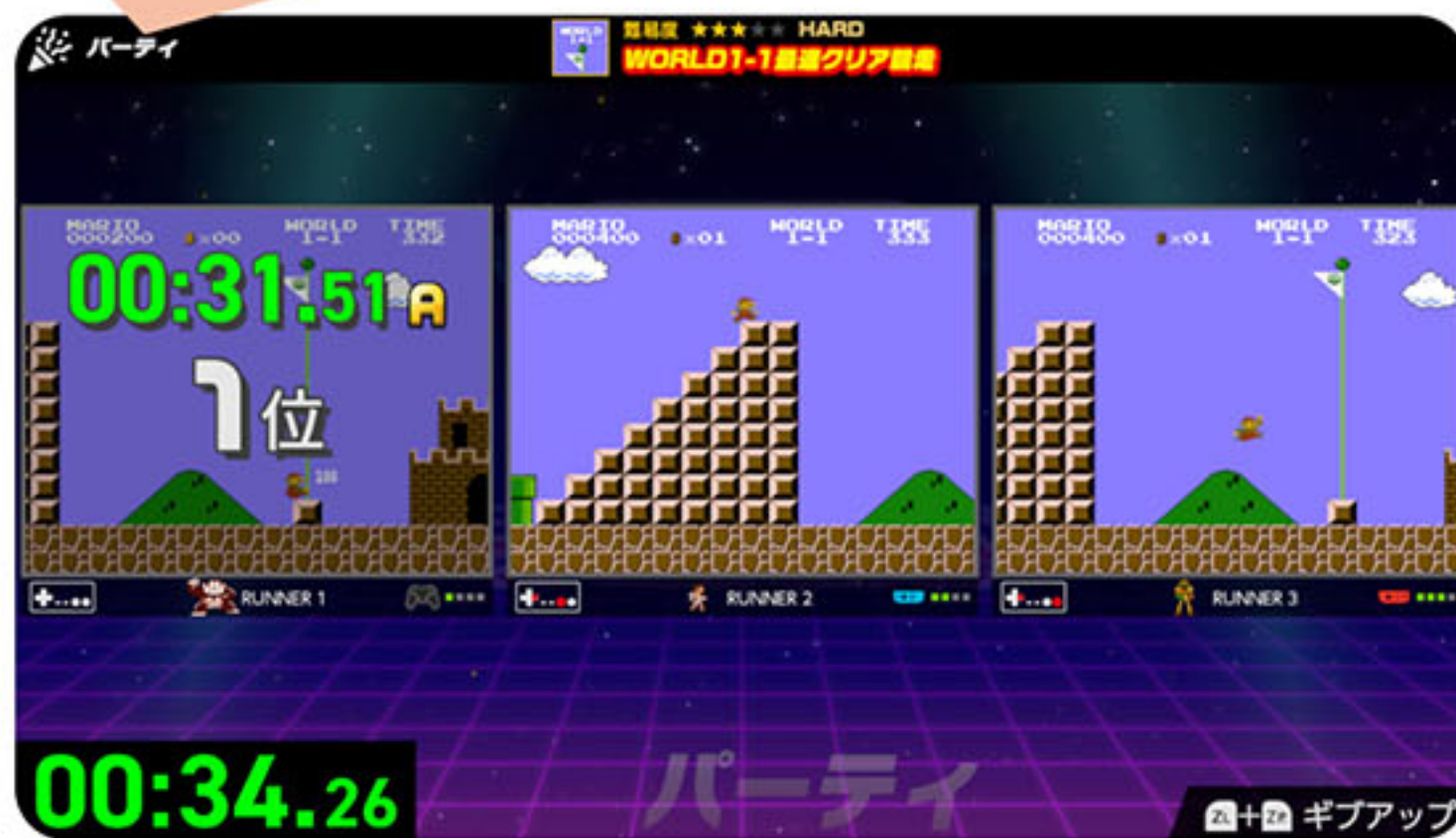

The Nintendo Museum opened on October 2nd on the site of Nintendo's former Uji Ogura Plant, a land from which amusements once sprung forth. We paid a visit to this facility where you can discover the history of the entertainment that Nintendo has been offering, from Hanafuda to Nintendo Switch, and experience its entertainment. We'll walk you through the entire facility, which is full of things to see and play with!



The Nintendo Uji Ogura Plant, originally known as the Uji Plant, was built in 1969. Since then, it has been used to manufacture Hanafuda and western playing cards. It also operated as a customer service center for product repairs. In 2024, it underwent a transformation and was reborn as a museum.

Nintendo's Ideas on Play

Explore

The giant controllers hanging from the ceiling indicate where the displays for each hardware platform are located. You are free to explore the exhibits in any order, whether you wish to trace Nintendo's history starting with Famicom or see the displays of your favorite hardware first.

*Photography and recording are not permitted in the 2nd-floor exhibition area.



The exhibits are divided into categories of hardware, from Famicom to Nintendo Switch. The titles released for each platform is lined up. In addition to the Japanese version, the North American and European versions are also on display, so you can see the differences among regions.



Nostalgic colors!

There are also exhibits on various themes. Many non-video game products, such as toys and board games, are also on display. You can see the history of Nintendo's creations with your own eyes.

Discover

There are Nintendo characters all over the museum. One of the fun things to do is to look around the exhibits and see where they are.



Amiibo figures are also on display.

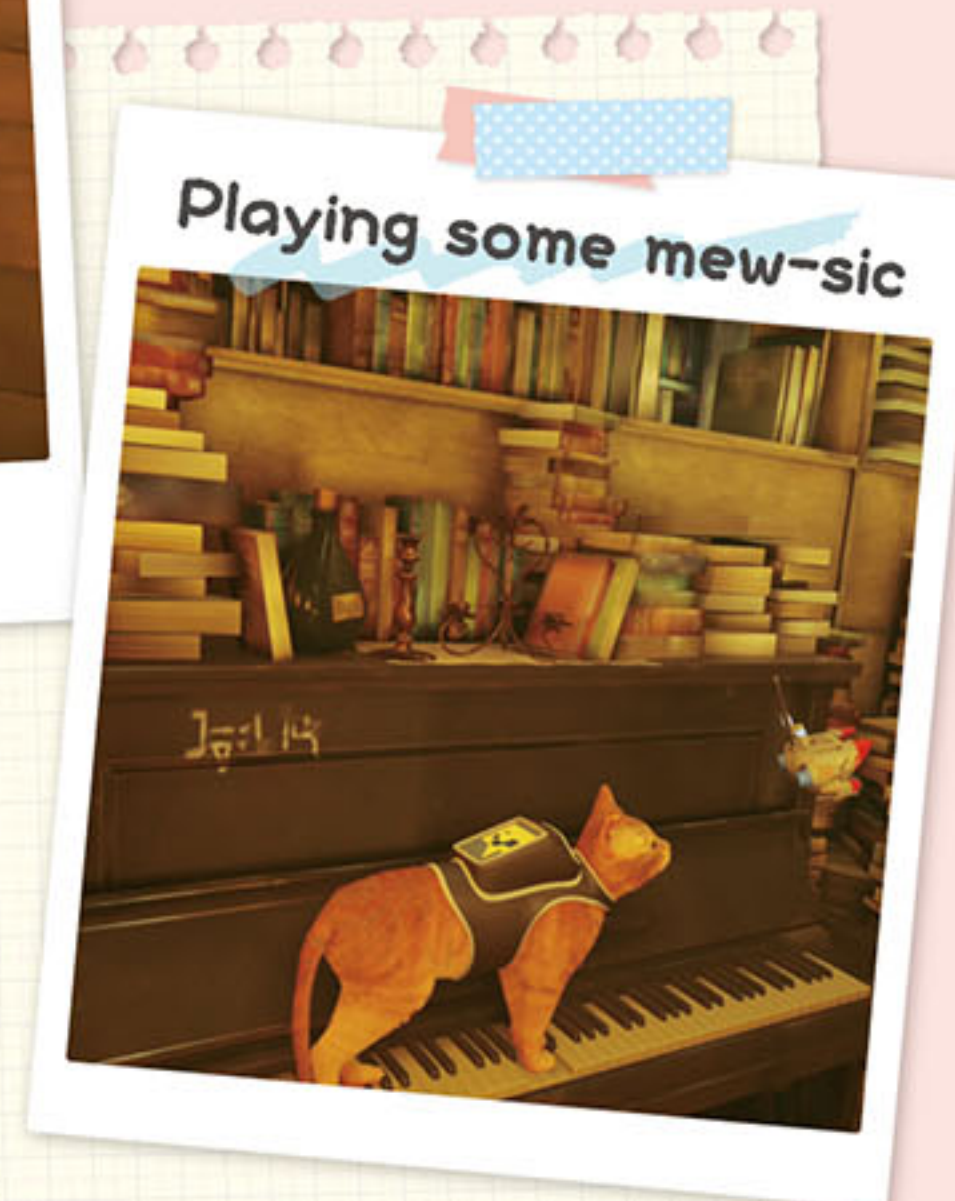

Pikmin Karuta

Currently there are a total of 9 Pikmin species in Pikmin 4. We will introduce their unique characteristics in the form of Karuta cards.

What is "karuta"?

Karuta is a traditional Japanese card game, where the cards consist of pairs of "yomifuda" (cards with only words) and "efuda" (cards with illustrations of the text). The yomifuda is read out loud, and the aim is to find its corresponding efuda faster than your opponents. To better distinguish the cards, the efuda largely displays the first sound (letter) of its accompanying text, often on one of its upper corners.
